Ms. Tomas has served several communities and associations, including Chairperson for the State Annual Conference Professional Development Committee, Chair for the FHSA Directors Affiliate Group, and Chair for the V.I.P Sub-Committee for Florida Head Start Association's Professional Development Committee.
