General Operations for Child Care Programs

- Licensing Requirements
 - Section 3.10 Sanitation
 - Section 3.11 Indoor Equipment
 - Section 6.1 Communicable Disease
- Department Emergency Order
- Inspections



Emergency Order

- EO deems Child Care essential
- To the extent possible Child Care remaining open at this time must:
 - Groups of 10 or less people;
 - Children and caregivers remain with one group;
 - Each group in separate room;
 - Groups do not interact or mix with other groups



CDC Guidance

- The Supplemental Guide for Child Care
 - Social distancing;
 - Child pick up and drop off procedures;
 - Cleaning and disinfecting of toys and bedding;
 - Safely caring for infants and toddlers; and
 - Food preparation and meal service



Partner Agency Resources

- OEL – School Readiness inspection extensions and First Responders program
- Child Care Food Program – waivers and relaxed requirements
