Rule

Florida Administrative Code [65C-20.008](#), [65C-22.001](#) and [65C-22.008](#) became effective Jan. 9, 2022.

Inspections

Classification Summaries [CF-FSP Form 5316](#), [CF-FSP Form 5317](#), and [CF-FSP Form 5427](#) now include corresponding standards for the alarm requirement. These standards will be monitored as applicable for providers that offer transportation services. Technical assistance will be provided during the next licensing inspection.

Training

The below courses were updated to reflect the new vehicle alarm requirement.

- Child Care Facility Rules and Regulations (RNRF)
- Family Child Care Home Rules and Regulations (HOME)
- Florida Child Care Personnel Orientation (CCPO)
- Health, Safety and Nutrition (HSAN)
- Opening a Child Care Facility (OPENF)
- Opening a Large Family Child Care Home (OLFC)
- Transportation Safety (TRS)
