FY21 Monitoring Highlights

- All reviews will be virtual
- CLASS[®] reviews are suspended until further notice
- Focus Area One reviews begin November
- Focus Area Two reviews begin January
- No planned unannounced reviews



FY21 Monitoring Process Changes

- Grantees will receive a 45-day notification letters through HSES correspondence
- Grantees will share information about comprehensive service delivery before and during the COVID-19 pandemic



FY21 Monitoring Overview

FA1 reviews will begin the week of Nov 2nd

- Virtual five-day review (1 reviewer)
- Opportunity for the grantees to describe the program's approach to providing quality services
- Daily discussions
- Grantee collaborates with the assigned reviewer to develop the schedule for the week, which includes the time and participants for each facilitated discussion



FY21 Monitoring Overview

FA2 reviews will begin the week of Jan 4th

Virtual five-day review (average team size is 4)

- Opportunity for the grantees to demonstrate the program's approach to providing quality services
- Includes virtual data tours, document reviews, fiscal explorations, and ERSEA file reviews
- Discussions are with Management Teams, staff, the governing bodies, and the policy council



Protocol Highlights

Grantees will have the opportunity to:

- Share the program's strengths, creativity, and approaches to providing quality services
- Discuss how CARES ACT funding is being used
- Describe how the program determines programmatic, child, and family outcomes
- Share ERSEA strategies
